

ASCEND(ED)	Verb [regular, transitive], /ə'send/: to <u>climb a mountain, stairs etc</u>
EFFICIENT	Adjective, /'ɪfɪʃ(ə)nt/ : someone who is efficient works well and quickly and is good at organizing their work in the way that gets the best results
HEARTH	Noun [countable], /hɑ:(r)θ/: the floor of a fireplace in a house and the area around it
SCUTTLE	Verb [intransitive], /'skʌt(ə)l/: to run somewhere with short quick steps
SARCASM	Noun (uncountable), /'sɑ:(r)kæz(ə)m/: the activity of saying or writing the opposite of what you mean, or of speaking in a way intended to make someone else feel stupid or show them that you are angry
IGNORANT	Adjective /'ɪgnərənt/: not knowing something that you should know or need to know
